BY-LAW No.899-22

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OYEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAWS 140, 158, 224, 294, 309, and 800-10.

WHEREAS, pursuant the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Town of Oyen;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Town of Oyen assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 140, 158, 224, 294, and 309 Bylaw".

THAT the following Bylaws be repealed as they are no longer deemed necessary to Town operations:

Bylaw #140 no one permitted to ride a bicycle on the sidewalk;

Bylaw 158 no trucks over ½ ton on Mainstreet;

Bylaw 224 construction material for businesses;

Bylaw 294 no discharge of firearms in town or within 2 miles outside of town;

Bylaw 309 closing hours for stores.

Bylaw 800-10 being the assessment of designated manufactured homes and reporting requirements.


2. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
3. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.

Read a first time this 9th day of August, 2022.


Read a second time this 9th day of August, 2022.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third and final reading this 9th day of August, 2022.

Read a third time and finally passed this 9th day of August, 2022.
